Re: New Wage Schedule for June 1, 2021

Gentlemen:

May 12, 2021 the Executive Board of Local 26 voted to split up the \$1.45 increment as agreed to with the Master Insulators Association of Rochester, NY, May 20, 2020 by the following manner: \$1.00 per hour into the Base Wage, \$.15 into the Welfare, \$.25 into the Pension and \$.05 per hour into the JAC. Fifth year Apprentice wages will be adjusted to 90% June 1, 2021. Dues structure increased \$.15.

(a) – Full Welfare Plan benefits begin after 1,000 hours of employment and the Employer contribution becomes **\$10.10** per hour worked.

(b) – Pension participation and employer pension contribution of **\$9.57** per hour worked begins after 1 year of service.

Dues Structure is \$2.96 per hour worked for Mechanics, fourth- and fifth-year apprentices on straight time \$4.44 for time and one half, \$5.92 for double time, \$8.88 for triple time hours worked. It is \$1.79 for first, second- and third-year apprentices per hour worked on straight time, \$2.69 for time and one half, \$3.58 for double time and \$5.37 on triple time hours worked.
